## Council Chambers Audio-Visual Technology Upgrade Questions

**Q: Is the rack going to be located in the same location that the old equipment was located?**

A: Yes / close by. We would like it against the north wall near where the clerk typically sits. This is about 5' from the existing audio mixer.

**Q: Does the speaker cabling come from the ceiling fished through the wall or in surface wire mold?**

A: The entire room is covered in a drop ceiling. All speaker wires route across this to cable conduits down the north wall into the mixer.

**Q: Is surface wire mold acceptable for cabling to the PTZ camera or will this be able to fish through the wall? I assume the walls are drywall?**

A: Yes wire mold is acceptable for running down the walls. There is drop ceiling over the entire room. Most of the walls are solid cement.

**Q: Is surface wire mold acceptable for cabling to the OFE TV for the camera and HDMI signal?**

A: Yes

**Q: Where is the TV located in relation to the rack?**

A: Tv is mounted on the west wall or left of the council dais.

**Q. Is there or will there be power located at the rack location?**

A: Yes, two 120 volt outlets are there.

**Q. Is it the intention that an Owner provided PC will be the interface between the presentation system and the Zoom service?**

A. Yes we have our own PC. Anyone should be able to bring in a device and plug into the clickshare dongle and start sharing on any service.
