<u>Curwood Painting</u>: Commissioner Greenway brought a painting to be donated to the Commission. The Commission decided to use it as a silent auction item at their Christmas party.

<u>Budget Amendment and Capital Improvements</u>: Commissioners reviewed and ranked a list of improvements to Curwood Castle, Comstock Cabin and the Paymaster building. Amy Fuller will use this information to start working on a budget amendment for them with the revenue from the Gould House included. Immediate priorities include trimming the shrubs, cleaning the carpet in the Castle, cleaning the Paymaster Building and Comstock Cabin and hiring someone to clean Curwood Castle. **Motion by Commissioner Little to move forward with a quote for \$3,700 to paint the Paymaster Building. Support by Hooper. Approved by voice vote.**

<u>Home Tour Updates</u>: The Commission discussed the home tour. The Independent is unable to print the booklet so the Committee is getting quotes for printing. They also discussed how many docents are needed.
