**SATA MILLAGE REQUEST**

Motion by Councilperson Ford to approve the following resolution effectively removing the SATA Millage question from the August 8, 2006 ballot:

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2006, the Owosso City Council approved Authorizing Resolution # 1 approving the articles of incorporation for the Shiawassee Area Transportation Authority and setting an August 8, 2006 date for placing before Owosso's voters a new millage for funding operations of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2006, the Owosso City Council also approved a resolution to certify to the County Clerk the language of the millage proposal to be placed on the August 8, 2006 ballot; and

WHEREAS, recent events have called into question the likelihood that a transportation authority will be established within the time originally envisioned by the Council when Authorizing Resolution # 1 and the millage proposal resolution were originally approved; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Owosso that the ballot for the August 8, 2006 election not contain a millage proposal the need for which now is uncertain;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby rescind Authorizing Resolution # 1 and the millage proposal resolution adopted on May 1, 2006 and directs the City Clerk to notify the County Clerk that it is the desire of the City Council that the transportation millage proposal not appear on the August 8, 2006 ballot.
