



**B. Parking in 100 Block of N. Washington Street.** Jamie Irish and Casey Voss from the Hair Peace outlined their preference for parking enforcement in the block. They prefer a business owner validation method with a very high fine for employer abuse of the system. Doug Peterson mentioned that he preferred to see another block meeting prior to a DDA recommendation to the Council. That meeting will take place before the April meeting of the DDA.

**C. Old Hotel Site Status.** Members discussed the upcoming Council decision on the Purchase Agreement with Fifth Third Bank for the lot. Discussion ensued about highest and best use. It was noted that a site plan would have to be approved before the sale could take place. The Agreement specifies what constitutes the standards for review of the site plan's adequacy for the best architectural and operational fit to this corner. Bill Gilbert would still like to see a park considered.

**D. DDA Budget for 2006-07.** There was no time for the budget review; therefore a special meeting of the DDA was established for Thursday, March 15th at 7:30 a.m. at the Owosso School Board Meeting Room in the Middle School. The other agenda item will be the Executive Session for consideration of property acquisition.
