

FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE FEES

Motion by Councilperson Robertson to adopt the following resolution establishing fees for fire and rescue services:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Owosso deems it necessary to establish fees for fire and rescue services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Owosso hereby approves the following fees for fire and rescue services:

SERVICES FOR WHICH THE FIRE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE REIMBUSED

The Fire Department shall be reimbursed whenever the Fire Department responds to an emergency. The emergency shall include, but not be limited to, motor vehicle accidents, residential, and commercial fires. Emergency services provided by the Fire Department shall include, but not be limited to, vehicle extrication through the use of specialized equipment, debris control, fluid containment, hazard control, scene lighting, and technical rescues.

INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED

Any person who is rendered any service by the Fire Department shall provide the following information:

- A. Name, address, and telephone number.
- B. Name and address of insurance carrier.
- C. Individuals receiving rescue services shall assist the Fire Department in providing any other necessary information for the Fire Department to properly bill for the services it provides.

FEES

The Owosso Fire Department shall be reimbursed for the fire service and other emergency services in the amount the user's insurance company will pay or the actual cost of the service provided which ever is less.

Fee Schedule: \$500.00 per hour includes trucks, equipment, and manpower minimum billing one hour.

Nothing in this resolution prohibits the Fire Department from directly billing for services that are not covered under the Michigan Hazardous Materials Response law that provides certain coverage for hazardous materials response through Shiawassee County Emergency Management Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above fees shall be effective May 14, 2005.
