The City of Owosso is seeking a qualified and experienced professional to serve as Deputy Director of Public Services. Under the direction of the Director of Public Services, this position assists with planning, directing, and overseeing the operations of the Public Services Department and serves as Director in their absence.

The Deputy Director will help oversee municipal infrastructure and services, including streets, water and sewer systems, stormwater, engineering, fleet and facility maintenance, parks and recreation, GIS, and capital improvement projects. Responsibilities also include staff supervision, budgeting, grant administration, regulatory compliance, project management, emergency response, and coordination with governmental agencies, contractors, developers, and the public.

Qualifications

- Minimum of 3 years of experience in public works management, engineering, construction management, business administration, or public administration.
- Minimum of 5 years of progressively responsible experience involving municipal public works design, construction, maintenance, and repair.
- Bachelor's degree preferred.
- Michigan Professional Engineer (PE) license preferred.
- Michigan S-2, F-3, or Wastewater C certification preferred.
- Strong leadership, communication, organizational, problem-solving, and project management skills.
- Ability to respond to emergencies on a 24-hour basis and attend meetings outside normal business hours.

The successful candidate will demonstrate sound judgment, diplomacy, initiative, and the ability to effectively lead staff and manage complex municipal projects and operations.
